INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

To the Board of Directors of Assam Roofing Limited Report on the Audit of Standalone Annual Financial Results

OPINION

We have audited the accompanying standalone annual financial statements of Assam Roofing Limited ("the Company") for the quarter and year ended 31st March, 2021, (the "Statement"), attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosures Requirements) Regulations 2015, as amended.

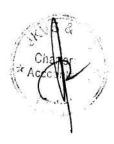
AUDITOR'S RESPONSIBILITIES FOR THE AUDIT OF THE STANDALONE FINANCIAL RESULTS
